Minutes

Director Don Full called the meeting to order and Ken Meyer opened with prayer. Chaplain Jay Hance read Philippians 3:12-14. The group sang "Make Me a Blessing," and then recited 2 Peter 3:9. Director Full reviewed the "Roman Road to Salvation," noting that the gospel can also be presented using just John 3:16. Jay Hance moved that the minutes of the October 3, 2016 meeting be approved and Cheryl Hance seconded the motion. Secretary Full noted one typographical error that she would correct. The minutes were approved as corrected.
