Minutes

Director Don Full called the meeting to order and Ken Meyer opened with prayer. Chaplain Jay Hance read Proverbs 3:1-6. The group sang “Make Me a Blessing,” and then recited 2 Peter 3:9. Director Full reviewed the “Roman Road to Salvation” and encouraged members to be prepared to present the plan of salvation. Jay Hance moved that the minutes of the February 6, 2017 meeting be approved and Cindy Mibbs seconded the motion. The minutes were approved as written. Susan Full distributed an updated contact list of F.A.I.T.H. Riders members and asked for corrections. Ken Meyer’s telephone number was then corrected.

Old Business

State road cleanup: The application has been delivered to IDOT but no response has been received to date.

Vacant Officer position: The office of Missions Coordinator remains vacant; the purpose of the position is to keep our organization outwardly focused.

Drag Strip Activities: Director Full distributed a list of all possibilities suggested by Jeff and Theresa Lasecke of the Central Illinois Dragway on January 19. Cleanup of the dragway prior to the opening is a priority. Members agreed that Friday, March 31 would be a good date for a workday at the dragway, starting at noon. Director Full will confirm that date with the Laseckes. Director Full will give the opening prayer each weekend; first race is April 29. Director will also contact Stan Hall of Hall’s Harley-Davidson regarding a booth at the dragway. Mark Jury clarified one item on the list, noting that the \$2,000 cost for a race sponsorship is actually for season-long track advertising.

2017 Calendar: Director Full distributed a draft of the 2017 calendar, noting that contact information had been added while destinations were omitted. The

date for the April Bike Night was corrected (from April 14 to April 21); plans for the event will be finalized at the April 3 meeting.

New Business

Food event at Farm & Home Store: At the November meeting the idea of serving free hot dogs at the Farm & Home was presented. Members were in favor of pursuing this idea and suggested a Friday in May (5, 12, or 19) would be a good time, serving from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Pam Pratt will contact the company about a date.

Missions Coordinator: Cheryl Hance volunteered to serve as Missions Coordinator. Jay Hance moved that we elect her to the office and Cindy Mibbs seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Outreach Director's Report: No report. Director Full noted that letters of invitation need to be sent to those on the list compiled last summer.

Webmaster's Report: No report. Director Full noted that Debbie is keeping the site up-to-date.
