The menu will be hot dogs, chips, and soft drinks. A signup sheet for condiments, chips, and drinks was circulated. Each member attending was asked to bring one package each of hot dogs and buns in order to have food for guests. We will use the Nolls’ hot dog cookers. Mark Jury suggested a trip to the Central Illinois Dragway following the meal.

Road Captain's Report: Lyle Lascelles reminded riders to watch out for animals—both alive and dead--on roadways while riding.

Promotion Director's Report: Cindy Mibbs will ensure the June 16 and June 23 (following confirmation) events are publicized via the Mason County Democrat.
